

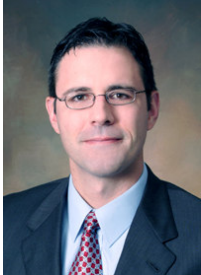

Engineering Students Seek Summer Employment

The York College Engineering Program is one of few engineering programs nationwide that requires all of its students to participate in one year of engineering cooperative work experience (co-op). Through this program, students have the opportunity to gain practical hands-on experience in industry and other engineering-related enterprises prior to graduation. After their first two years of study, students alternate academic semesters with semester-long periods of paid, professional engineering work experience in industry.

Students in mechanical, electrical and computer engineering are currently seeking full-time, temporary co-op opportunities for the summer (May through August.)

How does the co-op program benefit employers? Employers can...

- * Free up permanent employee's time for long term projects.
- * Hire flexible, highly motivated, technically capable employees at relatively low cost.
- * Bring in students whose new ideas and enthusiasm are often professionally stimulating to full time employees.
- * Assess the potential of an individual student for permanent employment after graduation
- * Reduce recruiting costs.
